

## **Palm Sunday**

### **Questions to discuss or think about**

1. Do you consider yourself to be a person who is at peace? What things are most prone to disrupt that peace?
2. Read Luke 19:28-44. What things in the story stand out to you as you read it this time?
3. Why do you think the crowds were so excited that Jesus was coming into Jerusalem? What did they expect him to do? (v37-38)
4. Jesus was the king, even though his actions were not going to be in the manner the people expected. Why do you think the religious leaders were so upset? Why did Jesus respond this way? (v39-40)
5. Jesus wept over the city. What do you think broke his heart? (v41-42)
6. What or who do you look towards in order to find peace in your life?
7. If we look to things other than Jesus for our peace, then what happens when our circumstances or life is changed or threatened?
8. Jesus not only felt mercy and compassion towards the people, but he acted towards them in mercy and compassion. How difficult is it to show mercy and compassion to people who don't deserve or understand? Since Jesus did this, how does it affect your opinion of him?
9. How can you feel and show mercy and compassion to others during the current crisis?
